DISCUSSION

MINUTES

+ The minutes of the May 13, 2024, meeting of the vestry were submitted for review and were approved, by unanimous consent.

TREASURER'S REPORT

+ David Pylipow provided a brief treasurer's report noting that per Leslie Urban our inflow and outflow continue to be good. Plumbing problems have affected the Building and Grounds budget but it remains healthy. Pledges continue coming in. Our Parish mortgage may conclude around \$200,000.

PARISH HALL REPORT

→ Dave Pylipow reported that construction is almost beyond nuts and bolts and getting to inside details. Bricks will be stained to match those of the original building. The priority is to obtain a Certificate of Occupancy, which is needed for the AV company to begin installing AV and sound systems. A small group of people will begin to arrange kitchen equipment, etc. James is preparing an updated Parish communication to come out soon.

2024 PRIORITIES UPDATES

- + Parish Hall Usage Committee: Many logistical parts were discussed during the committee's meeting and brainstorming session, noting a need to grow into using the new space slowly. Jessica Ewell will need to be involved and most likely need support as responsibilities increase. Using and learning the space will be limited to in-house events. Meal-packing will be the first event and, then, November 16 will be the big Parish celebration. When considering outside usage, as a non-profit: we cannot make money and we need to consider taxes, liability insurance, calendar conflicts, etc.
- + Increase Volunteers by Interest and Talent: Kevin and David have created an easy-to-digest list of all ministries and programs at St Alban's to be provided to newcomers and perhaps creating a separate parish-wide talent survey to be included with the annual giving campaign. This is something Carmen will want to review when she returns.
- + Revise Mission Statement: The vestry anticipates completing following Rev. Germino's return from sabbatical.
- **+** Martha Hartle reported that the new Coffee Hour process is off to a good start.



+ Parish Directory: Connor Fulton is gathering information to have something for us at the August meeting.
