


# CHILDREN'S CHAPEL OVER THE SUMMER

Our St. Alban's Anti-Racism Library is growing, thanks to the donations of the many good people of our parish. Located in the church narthex, it has books for people of all ages. Consider steering our younger generation to the library for something to read over the summer. Here are just a few examples of books for our youth:

For our youngest children we have All the Colors We Are: The Story of How We Get our Skin Color by Katie

Kissinger. It is a bilingual (English/Spanish) book celebrating the ways that we are special.

For ages 6-10 we have Freedom over Me, written and illustrated by Ashley Bryan. It was short-

listed for the 2016 Kirkus Prize and received a Newbery Honor.

For the Middle Grades you might enjoy *HEART AND SOUL: The Story of America and African Americans* by Kadir Nelson. It is the winner of numerous awards, including the 2012 Coretta Scott King Author Award and Illustrator Honor.

Young Adult books include *The Book Thief* by Markus Zusak, one of TIME Magazine's 100 best Young Adult books of all time.

There are a variety of books for Adults on our shelves including history, biographies, memoirs, historical fiction, non-fiction, and essay collections by esteemed scholars Nicole Hannah-Jones and Walter Brueggemann. If you'd like to pick up a best-selling page-turner, we have them, too. And of course, there is a section of books dealing with Racial Reckoning, Justice and Healing, which is now a priority within our North Carolina Diocese.

Sadly, a few of our books are missing. We want to encourage everyone to use our library, but please remember to return them so that everyone can enjoy them. To check out a book, just follow the instructions on top of the bookcase, fill out a library card, or ask Kathy Miller or Connor Fulton for assistance. 


#### **Introduction to Dismantling Racism**

"Bearing Witness" is the new, free, video-based study program from the American Friends of the Episcopal Diocese of Jerusalem (AFEDJ) that shares the stories of people living in Palestine and

Israel and the remarkable ministries of the Episcopal Diocese of Jerusalem that bring hope and healing in this volatile part of the world.

It is a particularly timely offering for those who want to have a deeper understanding and appreciation of the dynamics, gifts and challenges of belonging to a land that is shared by many faiths, ethnicities and nationalities. It's is a way of first listening, praying and discerning how God might be calling us to be in solidarity with our sisters and brothers in Jerusalem, Gaza, the Galilee,

the West Bank and the entire area where Jesus lived, taught, and gave himself up to the glory of God and for the sake of creating beloved community on earth. It models what it means to walk in love in one of the hardest regions on earth, and recalibrates our hearts and our ministries in the process.

This first diocesan-wide offering is ideal for anyone who simply wants to explore the course, or would like to experience it with the goal of becoming a course facilitator. Registering once will provide you access to all sessions.
